... Pignone sale. Avalon Properties Ltd., an Orlando residential developer, has purchased a 360-acre tract near the Lake-Orange County border for \$1.95 million from Frances S. Pignone, a former Orange County commissioner; her sister, Rita S. Simpson of Boulder, Colo.; and her aunt, Viola Sharp. The all-cash sale closed Feb. 26.

The sale price equates to \$5,417 per acre, or 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cents per square foot. The property is on the west side of State Road 545, south of Hartzog Road, which is just south of Lake Hickory Nut in Or-

ange County.

Pignone's mother, Angeline V. Sharp, had named Pignone personal representative of her estate before she

died May 31, 1987 at 82..

Pignone sold a 17.56-acre parcel near Lake Conway in south Orlando for \$2.3 million on April 28, 1994, to John H. Day, a former director of Orange Bank and a residential builder since 1983. That sale price equates to \$130,979 per acre, or \$3 per square foot.
