County buys 1,334 acres for conservation

A 1,334-acre tract that includes the headwaters of the Econlockhatchee River in southeast Orange County was sold Friday for \$3.75 million. The buyer was Orange County, which bought the land for conservation purposes. The seller was **Holland Properties Inc.** The land is about 5 miles southeast of Lake Hart. **Maury L. Carter and Associates** and **CB Richard Ellis Inc.** were the brokerages involved in the transaction.
