900 NEW HOMES ON TAP FOR West orange county

Several homebuilders and landowners want to bring more than 900 new residences to west Orange County communities such as Windermere and Horizon West.

Florham Park, N.J.-based developers Ridgewood Real Estate Partners and New York-based Angelo, Gordon & Co. LP are leading the charge with a plan for 423 single-family and townhome lots on 126.15 acres south of Central Florida Parkway and east of Westwood Boulevard.

Other residential projects seeking approval from the Orange County Commission includes:

- Meritage Homes has plans to build 151 homes in The Preserve at Westside, a new residential neighborhood set to be part of the Westside mixed-use development.
- ▶ Madden, Moorhead & Glunt Inc. has a

preliminary subdivision plan for Bella Vita, a new 11-home subdivision to be built on 13.81 acres at Park Ridge Gotha Road and Maguire Road in Windermere.

- Local land expert Daryl Carter wants to rezone four parcels totaling 61 acres from agricultural to planned development to allow for 285 homes.
- Unicorp National Developments Inc. wants to increase its planned Zen Luxury Living apartment complex near Disney from 231 to 258 units.
