

Beucher family selling undeveloped land, finished lots at Lake's Mission Inn Resort

According to an article written by Laura Kinsler with GrowthSpotter, Maury L. Carter & Associates, Inc. will be representing the Beucher family in the sale of 500 acres of undeveloped land that has residential entitlements, pad-ready townhome sites and dozens of finished lots, which are adjacent or nearby the already existing Mission Inn Resort and their two golf courses, Las Colinas and El Campeon Golf Course. There is also a 1.45 acre commercial site directly in front of the Mission Inn Resort's entry gate that currently houses a real estate office, but has the potential to be redeveloped for retail use if approved by the resort owner.

Laura Kinsler quoted Daryl Carter, President of Maury L. Carter & Associates, Inc. saying:

"This is an active community that already has a mature residential component," Carter said. "We're going to bring some major builders to the resort to take advantage of the value and brand that Mission Inn has already created out there."

Developers have already started showing interest in the offering according to Daryl Carter. "It would be nice if one developer could come in and take down all of the townhome pads" Carter said. There are five townhouse pads overlooking the El Campeon Golf Course, with 21 villa lots, eight club lots, and four duplex lots that are on the Las Colinas golf course.
