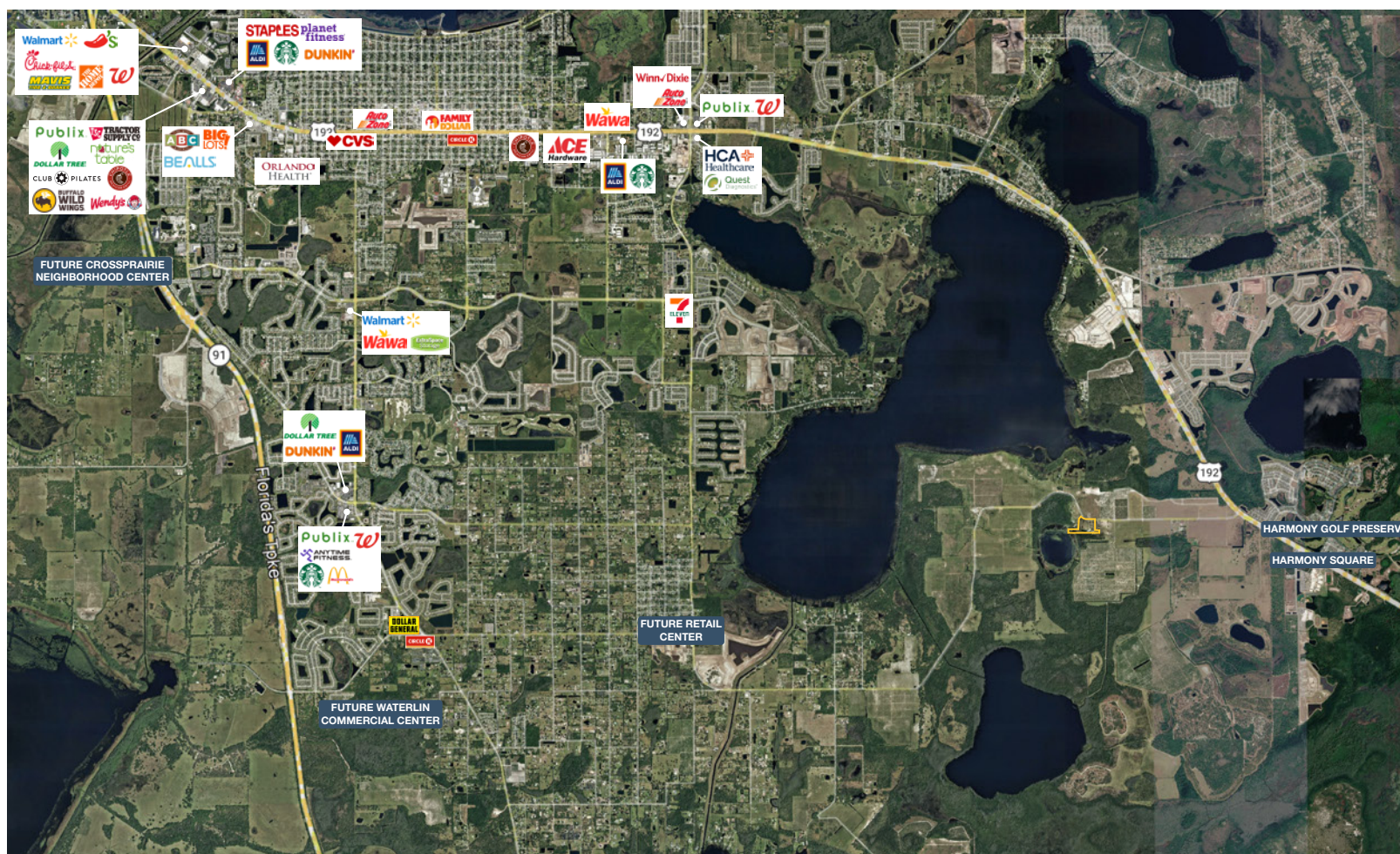

Growth in the Cloud: Long overshadowed, St. Cloud is quickly becoming a centerpiece of Central Florida's momentum.

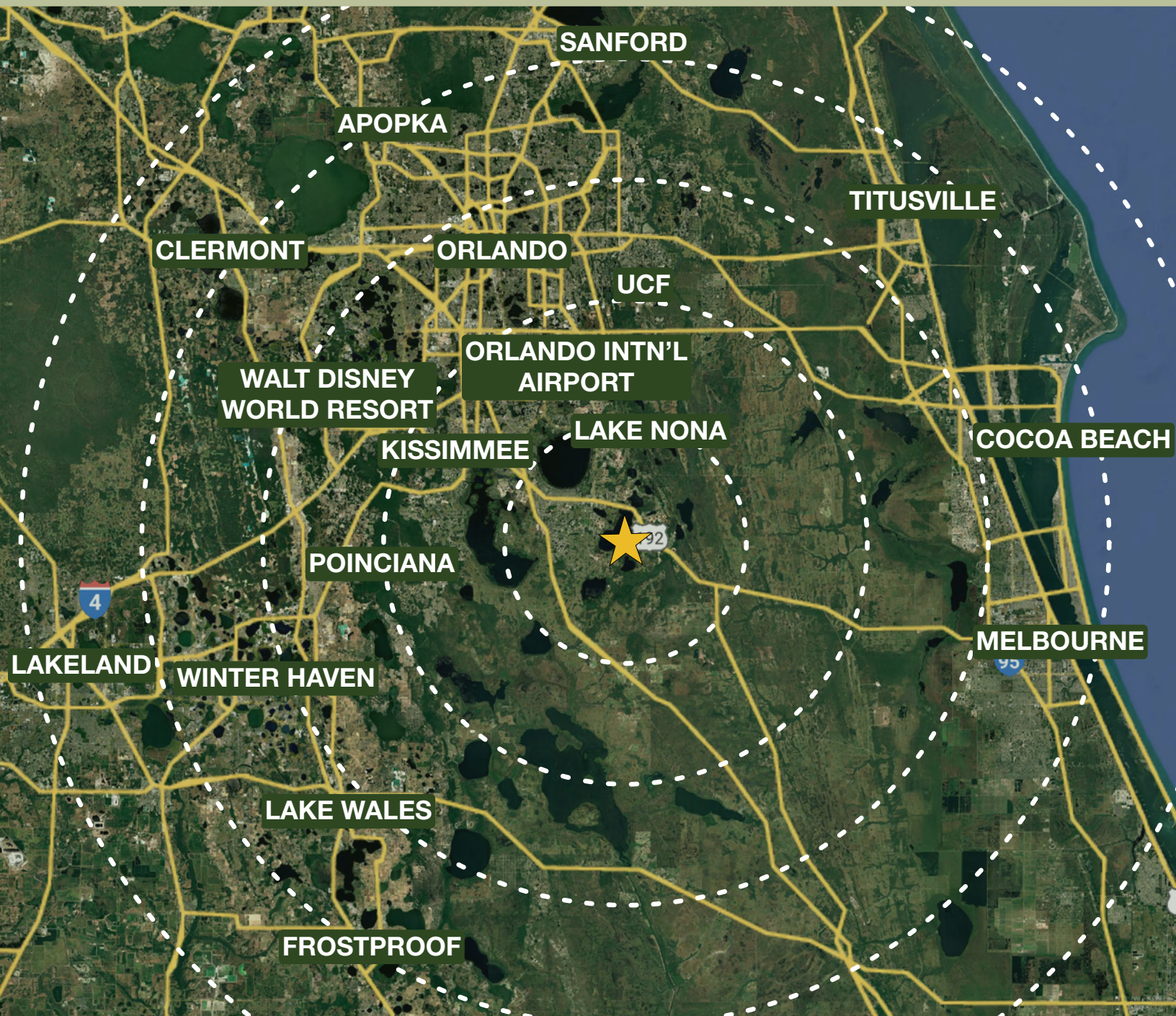
